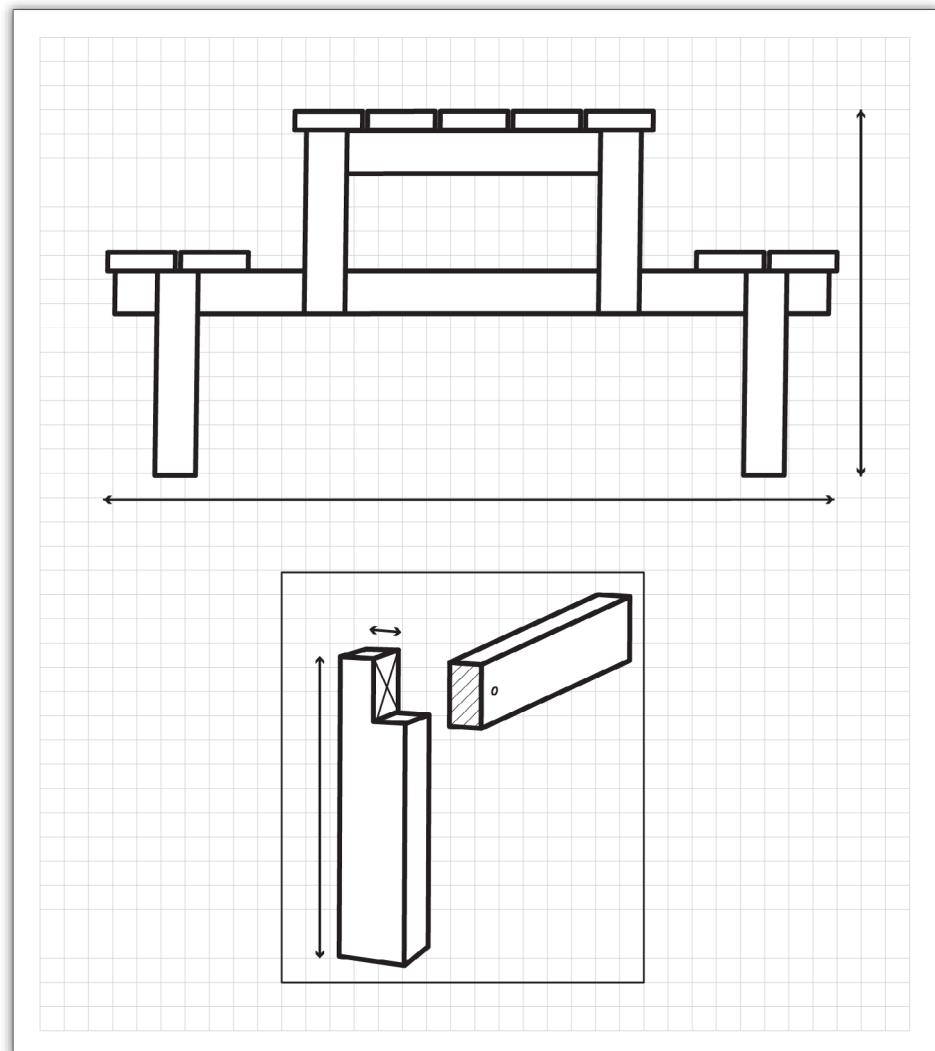

Assessment: Sketches and drawings

Learner instructions

This assessment is about creating comprehensive sketches and drawings for a BCATS project.

You need to show you can do these things without being prompted:

- Create refined sketches that clearly communicate project ideas.
- Create precise formal drawings that communicate detailed project information.
Note: you can use computer-assisted design programmes to create your formal drawings.
- Look after the sketches and drawings to avoid damage.



Your teacher will observe you creating your sketches and drawings. They will provide comments in this assessment resource as evidence to support their observations.

You will also need to provide the following evidence to support this. Submit it using myBCITO or the process at your school/organisation.



Refined sketches and formal drawings you created for your BCATS project.

Use the assessment checklist in this resource to keep track of the evidence you have collected.

The grade you are awarded will be based on your ability to create detailed and precise sketches and fully annotated formal drawings that communicate all necessary project information.

Create sketches and drawings

For this assessment activity, you need to show you can do these things for your project without being prompted.

- Create detailed sketches that clearly communicate your ideas for the project. They need to have accurate annotations and measurements.
- Create fully annotated and detailed formal drawings that include all information needed to create the project. The drawings must include symbols and abbreviations. You need to include third-angle orthographic projections with elevations, plans, and cross-sections. Isometric and oblique projections are optional.
- Store the sketches and drawings safely to avoid damage.



Your teacher will observe you creating your sketches and drawings.

Below is the other evidence you need to collect during your practical work. You should work with your teacher to make sure you've provided everything needed.
