



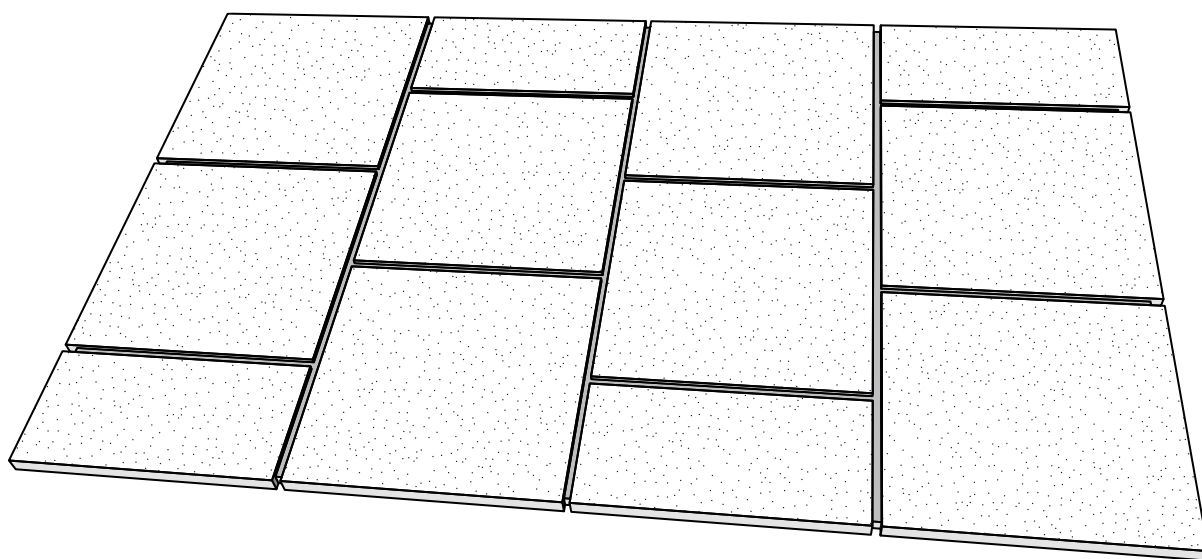

This assessment is about using trade skills to lay pavers as a BCATS project.

You need to show you can do these things without being prompted:

- Prepare a detailed materials list.
- Complete the project to a high standard.

The standard will not be signed off until you have completed the project.

Your teacher will observe you working throughout your project. They will provide comments in this assessment resource as evidence to support their observations.

You will need to provide the following evidence to support this. Submit it using myBCITO or the process at your school/organisation.

A completed *Project record* template, showing the tasks and quality checks you carried out, feedback you received, and any changes you made.
